- ◆ We can accommodate groups ranging up to 15 to 100 people.
- ◆ All guests must be over the age of 18 to consume any alcohol
- ◆ Unfortunately we are unable to adjust music volumes to accommodate for speeches
- ◆ We can provide food platters as required from our platter menu.
- ◆ Food platters are suggested as 1 platter per approximately 10 - 15 people.
- ◆ We are unfortunately unable to reserve tables or take bookings for designated areas when ordering platters.
- ◆ We require that you order, pay in full and confirm your platters a minimum of three (3) days before the date of function.
- ◆ In the event that you need to cancel your platter(s) order we require no less than 48 hours notice, prior to the date of your function, to ensure that any part or full payment can be refunded.
- ◆ Payments can be made by cash, eftpos or credit card.
Unfortunately cheques will not be accepted
- ◆ The Queens is operating under an accredited Food Safety Program. In the interest of patron safety all food must be consumed on premise.
- ◆ We are able to provide a bar tab on request for food and beverage
(credit card required)
- ◆ We do not accept functions for 18th Birthdays.
- ◆ Any guests deemed by the Queens Staff to be intoxicated may be asked to leave the premises
- ◆ The Queens is a public bar, and as part of our licence we have to regulate the number of people in the venue, both upstairs and downstairs. In the event that we reach licence capacity, entry, or re-entry may be delayed if there is a queue to access the venue downstairs or up.
